Hello, my name is Matthew Szymanski. I am a seminarian for the Diocese of La Crosse. A little bit about me....

I am the youngest of seven kids. I have an identical twin brother, Luke. I was born in Hartford, CT, but lived in a small Western Massachusetts town till I was 6 years old. My family then moved to southwest Kansas, Garden City. I lived there till I graduated high school when I was 17.

I felt God's call to be a priest when I was 15 years old. I am proud to have served active duty for four years in the United States Army. I was a paratrooper in the 82nd Airborne Division at Fort Bragg, NC. I had 25 mass tactical static line parachute jumps. I served from 1990 to 1994 and was honorably discharged with the rank of Sergeant, E-5 when my four-year enlistment was finished.

After my time in the Army, I studied to be a priest for the Archdiocese of Chicago. I graduated from the minor seminary for the Archdiocese, *(continued on page 2)*

(continued from page 1) St. Joseph Seminary. I then went for theology studies at St. Mary of the Lake Seminary, also known as Mundelein Seminary. I was unsure of my vocation, and I left the seminary before the first semester ended.

I served as a police officer in Garden City, KS, for a year, then moved back to Chicago. I was a police officer for twenty and a half years with the Northbrook Police Department, a suburb of Chicago. I worked as a patrol officer for ten years, a detective for five years, and a patrol sergeant for my last five and a half years. I still felt a call to the priesthood for all those years after I left the seminary.

I retired from the police department in 2020, moved to Wisconsin, and became a seminarian for the Diocese of La Crosse. I just finished my third year of theology school at St. Francis de Sales Seminary in Milwaukee and will be ordained a transitional deacon on June 1st. I am looking forward to serving the parishes in Viroqua and Coon Valley this summer. God bless you all.
