Hello St. Mary's Viroqua and Coon Valley Parents,

I would like to invite all of you to a Religious Education (RE) informational session on Sunday, September 8th in Viroqua after the 10:30 am Mass. Father Joe will introduce Pat Obernberger (the new Coordinator of Ongoing formation), the instructors for the Pre-K RE program, the Confirmation program and myself (I help with our Family of Faith RE program). If you are unable to make it to the informational session, Teresa Brown will also be at the first Community Activity in Coon Valley on October 20th after the 8 am Mass to provide safe environment training to those who have not completed it.
