Some personal history to catch you up – before seminary I was a FOCUS missionary, working primarily at the University of Minnesota Duluth with college students, leading Bible studies, coaching and mentoring, praying with them, and working together on a relationship with Christ. *(continued from page 1)* few Mass adjustments. First, January 1, is the Solemnity of Mary Mother of God, also a Holy Day of Obligation. This Tuesday Fr. Parr (a Viroqua local) will celebrate a vigil Mass in Coon Valley at 5:15, and on Wednesday he'll celebrate 12:10 and 5:15 Masses in Viroqua. There will be no daily Mass on January 2 or 3, but the weekend will be business as usual. Finally, there will not be daily Mass on January 7; but on January 8, I'll be back in the saddle for our routine schedule.

Over the course of Advent, we set about the ambitious project of adoration every single day of the week. It was ambitious, and I was very happy with it. Three things. First, it is no longer Advent, so that extraordinary schedule no longer stands. Second, January 8, onward we'll return to our customary adoration times from 4:30 -5:00 on Tuesdays in Coon Valley and 5:45-6:30 on Wednesdays in Viroqua. If you got something out of coming to one of those Advent adoration times (or, for that matter, if some other practice you took on was a Help), please be free to explore adding it into your regular schedule, too. Third, and finally, if you have any feedback on adoration times (such as "hey, that noon time was really helpful"), let me know. I can't guarantee it'll necessarily lead to a shift, but in my efforts to find what works best with y'all's (technical term) schedule that will be helpful information.
