# Annunciation of the **Blessed Virgin Mary** Parish



Hello friends,

On Wednesday morning last week, I put the last period in one notebook (sage green) and cracked open a new one. For a decade or two I've found spiritual journaling a helpful exercise in prayer – less of a historical record (although if my cause for canonization ever comes up, my journals will be a powerful aid for the devil's advocate [a real role]), and more of a method to slow down my mind and heart and speak what I want to speak directly to Jesus. Those journals hold everything from my own reflections on scripture and reading to puzzling through hard pastoral situations to processing the different hats I wear. I highly recommend it if you ever ask the question, "but what do I even do when I pray?" Liturgical prayer, thanksgiving and petition, intercession, these are all building blocks in our relationship with the Lord. Beyond those, if you ever struggle with the aspect of simply spending time with Jesus, a spiritual journal and sitting in the silence with Him can be a tremendous help.

Anyhow, after putting that last period down I flipped back to the first entry in that notebook, dated January 1, 2024. This was just about a year and a half into my pastorship here, and seeing that date got me thinking on how we're coming up on three years together. To put it simply, I am grateful for this time. I was not expecting to become a pastor quite so early into my priesthood, but I have found your openness to the Holy Spirit heartening. For all the transition and seasons my two parishes have seen, you have a remarkable resilience (continued on page 2)

I am grateful for our chemistry, to work toward and through our own collaboration as distinct parishes in communion with each other, to listen for the Lord's voice together and try our derndest to respond to it. I am grateful that the Lord has given me this assignment to jump in to pastorship, sometimes head first, sometimes feet first, sometimes with a belly flop.

Perhaps this all feels like I'm building up to an announcement – I'm not. I just want to acknowledge my own experience looking back on that last year and a half of building and listening, at the year and a half before it of getting to know each other and my own figuring out the parishes, and to express a simple curiosity for where the Lord is leading us over the course of my new journal (this one's maroon). I've mentioned a few extra roles I've taken on with deanship and this diocesan rebuilding & renewal committee – those tertiary roles will inform the next year and a half of notebook pages, as will my secondary role as your Pastor and my primary role as a disciple of Jesus Christ. Let's see where He leads us.


