(continued from page 1) us had a needed moment to break bread down at the Driftless. Thank you to everyone who providentially prayed with us Wednesday evening!

Wednesday evening also coincided with the memorial of a set of saints you may be unfamiliar with – St. Augustine Zhao Rong and his companions. St. Augustine & co. represent a community of Chinese martyrs who laid down their lives over almost a millennium and a half of evangelization in China – a work that's still continuing today. It's a telling and powerful thing when a foreign missionary serves and sacrifices in a foreign land – he or she is saying, "the Lord's love and Gospel mission are so important that I'm willing to lay it all down with a people who aren't even my own." It reveals the catching effectiveness of the Gospel even more when missionaries are raised up in the ministered-to community – when, despite ongoing hostility and resistance – the Gospel catches on enough to move new converts to follow Christ all the way. To put that more clearly, a mark of missionary success is the raising up of disciples and saints and martyrs and missionaries among the community being directly served. St. Augustine Zhao Rong and his companions fit this model – they were Chinese locals served by foreign missionaries who laid down their lives following Jesus Christ among their own people.

All this came together Wednesday evening – remembering Pat and Ed and the home that, among other life artifacts, raised up a priest; celebrating the anniversary of one of our own locals who's laid down 25 years of his life (and more to come) to leave home and carry the Gospel with him; and honoring this community of martyrs who've received the Gospel, given it space to expand, and carried it out with them. These are some of the benchmarks of success I'm striving for – as a foreign missionary to this land (I'm a native Californian and more recently a native La Crossian) working to raise up local missionaries and disciples and saints and martyrs in this land, and it is beautiful to see you responding with open hearts to our Lord's invitation. We are in good company!
