(continued from page 1) afternoon, let's go" – you're the folks who turn this from a lot of energy and effort and coordination into, quite simply, a great event that gets off the ground. Across all these groups, I simply want to thank everyone who came to enjoy and help pull off this weekend!

I think this also all fits very well with this missionary theme I've been building up over the last few months. Again, the story I see playing out to answer the question "what is a missionary?" is someone who A) hears an invitation from the Lord, B) says "yes," and C) starts moving their feet. There can be a devilish little temptation hidden in there to see easily, visibly expansive examples of missionaries (e.g., Missionaries of Charity, Maryknoll, FOCUS, etc.) who have formally entered the work of evangelization and disciple formation and let the sentiments "I'm so far from that" or "I don't feel called to go that big" stop you in your tracks. Of course, the big problem with this is that, while some individuals are called to such expansive and visible ministry, the Holy Spirit does most of His work one person, one moment at a time.

Something like yesterday is a great example of some folks seeing the need (that being one type of invitation from the Lord) for community building, outreach, and momentum a few years ago, answering with a "yes," and taking tangible footsteps. Of course, this was also quite a Big Thing – the fruit of many folks' coordination and input. Sometimes missionary work is big like that. More often it's a matter of invitation to Mass or coffee or a Bible Study. Even more often it's a matter of the long work of accompaniment – meeting folks in the present moment, walking with them and avoiding the temptation to bypass the spiritual work to get to the tidy end result you or I might have in mind for them (e.g., Sunday Mass attendance, kicking the habit of mortal sin, etc.). I have enjoyed the decision to be a missionary disciple since I first made it a decade and change ago, and I invite you to make it yourself (if you haven't yet) or to keep walking deeper into it (if you've started down the Way).


