Vacation Bible School

Hello friends,

First, a big thank you to everyone who weathered what I think was a career-long homily last weekend. I used Peter and Paul's missionary example to comment on the missionary season we're entering in the Church locally and broadly – motivated partly by issues we've seen for a long time (decline in numbers of priests and parishioners), but even more by the clear opportunity for evangelization in front of us (again, in the 40,000+ people attending Mass every weekend, we're serving 4.5% of the total population in the geographic diocese, meaning there are 95.5% of people waiting to receive the restorative power of the Gospel). To define again "what is a missionary," a missionary is someone who perceives God's invitation to work/labor/mission (which means "being sent"), who says "yes," and who starts moving their feet.

This momentum has a local flavor (people aren't saved and drawn into community by programs or institutional change but by Jesus Christ) and a broad diocesan flavor as we ask big questions about the needs in front of us, the resources in our hands, and the way the Holy Spirit is leading us. We're intentionally choosing to be moved based on vitality (what gives us life) rather than viability. I promised to share the benchmark signs of parish vitality we've been discerning with you, and while I may preach on them this weekend I'd like to get them down in writing for those of you (like me) who need time to digest and mull. Here is a condensed version of the seven signs of vitality we are working from:

1. Thriving Sunday Masses: Masses are celebrated in a dignified manner that draws the heart to God, attracts newcomers, and builds up the People of God. (continued on page 2)

- 2. *(continued from page 1)* Stable and Healthy Leadership: Supporting clergy and lay leadership with collaboration, consistent tenure, realistic workload, and Gospel-oriented vision.
- 3. A Culture of Discipleship: Members have been and continue to be transformed by a joyful encounter with Christ that motivates their prayer, service, and integrated life.
- 4. A Culture of Accompaniment: Parishes are marked by hospitality, opportunity for onboarding, and the follow-through to walk with newcomers and each other in their stories.
- 5. Missionary Outreach: Parishioners are interested, involved and motivated to reach out to the poor, the outcast, inactive members, non-Christians, and those on the margins.
- 6. Faith Formation: Families engage their role as the primary place of formation and opportunities within the parish support the development of Christian disciples.
- 7. Stewardship: Parishioners engage their gifts of service, financial support, and discernment to support the work of the parish and the Church's mission.
