Annunciation of the **Blessed Virgin Mary** Parish



Friends,

This week I want to share a simple prayer that my spiritual director recently shared with me – the "Unity Prayer" from Elizabeth Kindelmann's *Flame of Love*. Notice the wording in here – a series of personal elements (feet, hands, hearts, souls, thoughts, ears, glances, and lips) and dispositions (those of togetherness, unity, unison, harmony, and hope for mercy) – yet all are rooted in the primary naming "My adorable Jesus," and request for Him to lead. Importantly, this is the difference between an encouraging or sentimental aphorism (also good, but different) and a prayer – the former is directed to self, the latter is directed to the Lord. This is an important reminder that the work of Christian living is before anything I do Christ's own work in me and you. Anyway, it is a beautiful prayer and I'll let it speak for itself.

The Unity Prayer

My adorable Jesus,

May our feet journey together;

May our hands gather in unity;

May our hearts beat in unison;

May our souls be in harmony;

May our thoughts be as one;

May our ears listen to the silence together;

May our glances profoundly penetrate each other;

May our lips pray together to gain mercy from the eternal Father, amen.

Hello Parish Family! We will be starting our Montessori-based Early Childhood programming, Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS), the week of October 20th. In very short form, the CGS is a place for children to encounter Our Lord through prayer and working with intentionally created materials made for their particular spiritual needs. We had two Level 1 (3-6 year old) sessions per week last year, and we are expanding this year by adding in two Level 2 (6-9 year old) sessions per week. Our options for this year are as follows:


